Subject：Supreme Court of India Orders－Curbing Ragging in Educational Institartions－ Inclusion of No of Raggine Incidents in Prospectus／Brochures．

SirlMadam，
In continuation of this Office letter of even a0．dated 03．03．2008，on the above subject，I am directed to say that the Hon＇ble Supreme Court of India in SLP（C）No，24295／2004 in the matter of University of Kerala v／s Council of Principals，Colleges of Kerala and others，the Apex Cour has expressed displeasute on the incidents of ragging in the educational institutions despite directions to prevent such inciderts in educational institurions．
（2）In the last hearing held on $10^{\text {th }}$ December， 2007 in the case related to prevention of raggin in higher educational institutious the Supreme Court has expressed concem over the incidence of ragging occurring in bigher ecfucational institutions and the need to eliminating it altogether．Accordingly，as direcled by the Court，instructions bave been issued by the regulatory bodies like UGC／AICTE／MCI etc．，for inclusion of the clause in the prospectus regerding punishment of students with expulsion etc，if found guilty of ragging．The Cormitiee set up by the Supreme Court to Monitor the measurs being taken to prevent ragging has now decided that along with the number of coses of ragging in the previous acaderaic session，the punistuments awarded to those found gailty should also be mentioned in the brochores／prospectus of the higher educational institution．
（3）It may alse be stated that the Report of the Raghavan Commitee constituted as per＇ birections of the Supreme Court of Indiato give suggestions on means of prevestion of ragging in educational instioutions，is already posted on UJCC web site mwwuge．ac．in The prescribed format fot tompliance report already enonged vide UGC office letter of even number anted $20^{\text {ih }}$ November， 2007.

(4) The Second meeting of Raghavan Committee to Monitor Measures to Prevent Paging in Higher Educational Institutions appointed by the Supreme Court of India constituted by Ministry of Hunan Resource Development headed by Dr. K. Roghavan, Ex-Director of ger was held on 02.04.2008 in New Delhi and the Com mite has inter-alia given the following. tractors. to all regulatory bodies;

That the Uaiversities/Colleges should mention in their prospectasibrocbure that the total number of "Ragging Incidents" taken pleat in their Institution in each year for information to the public.
(5) The Ministry of Hummer Resource Development Government of In da, Depatacit as Higher Education, vide their lew ce No. 9-18/2008 (U-5) dared $29^{\text {th }}$ April, 2008 has requested to ta up suitable campaigns against ragging inter ali suggesting the following:

The Institutions may erect suitable hoardings/bill boardsfanners in prominent places Within the campus exhort the students to prevent or not to indulge in ragging and also indicating therein the names of the officials and their telephone number to be contacted in sase of ragging.

The Educational institutions may also undertake any other form campaigns as it may consider appropriate for prevention of ragging.
