PROPOSAL UNDER PM-USHA COMPONENT-5: GENDER INCLUSION AND EQUITY INITIATIVES

About the college:

Govt. College for Girls, Pillukhera (Jind) was established in 2019 with an objective to promote and enhance the enrollment of the female students in Higher Educational Institutions. By dint of sheer hard work and assiduous efforts of the learned faculty coupled with the visionary approach of the Head of the Institution, this college has succeeded in enrolling more than three hundred and fifty female students from rural areas. The college has been running social-outreach programme for promoting female education for the last two years. The college faculty visits almost all the senior secondary schools situated in the neighboring villages to hold a friendly and motivational talk with the female students and thereby counselling and making them aware about the benefits of higher education. But the aspirations and expectations which they dream of before taking admission are deflated a wee bit when they find the college lacking in basic infrastructure necessary for imparting quality education to the students. There are no smart classrooms, no sports items, no trainer/coach/Prof. of Physical Education, no musical-instruments and costumes necessary for cultural activities/events. Most of the female students hail from remote areas where there is poor conveyance facility which, in turn, discourages the parents from getting their daughters admitted to this college. With an aim to facilitate the cause of Pradhan Mantri Uchchtar Shiksha Abhiyan to attain higher levels of access, equity and excellence in the State higher education system with greater efficiency and transparency, the college has drafted a proposal for receiving grant under component 5 of PM-USHA scheme so that it may provide the following facilities to the female students and transgenders residing in the rural locale.
