OFFICE ORDER

In Continuation of the College office order no. MJGCGPK/2025/3647 dated 17/12/2025.

Subject: Mandatory compliance with directions issued by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Suo Moto writ petition (civil) no. 5 of 2025 dated 07th November 2025 - "City Hounded by Strays, Kids Pay Price" - Within College Campus.

1. Background and Necessity: In reference to the letter No. 1/16-2024 Ad(1) dated 25th November 2025 issued by the Office of the Director General, Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has expressed grave concern regarding the alarming increase in dog-bite incidents within educational institutions, particularly in college campuses. The Supreme Court has issued strict directions that the management of educational institutions must ensure the fundamental right to life and safety of citizens, especially children, students, and staff, as guaranteed under Article 21 of the Constitution of India. These directions must be implemented immediately and with absolute strictness.

2. Principal Directions of The Supreme Court

- 2.1 Physical Security Measures (Paragraph 25(B)):** The college premises shall be fully protected from unauthorized entry of stray dogs by constructing or reinforcing adequate boundary walls, iron fencing, strong main gates, and other necessary structural measures. (This work must be completed within 8 weeks).
- 2.2 Cleanliness and Maintenance (Paragraph 25(C)):** All classrooms, corridors, staircases, toilets, and open spaces shall be kept under continuous and strict surveillance to maintain hygiene. No garbage, food waste, or other attractive materials shall be allowed to accumulate.
- 2.3 Regular Inspection (Paragraph 25(D)):** The local municipal authority shall conduct regular inspection at least once every three months to ensure no stray dogs are habiting within premises.
- 2.4 Immediate Removal of Stray Dogs (Paragraph 25(E)):** If any stray dog is found, the municipal authority shall immediately capture and shift it to designated shelter. Such dogs shall NOT be released back to the same location.
- 2.5 Awareness Programs (Paragraph 25(G)):** The college shall organize regular lectures, seminars, and awareness campaigns covering safe dog behavior, first-aid procedures, rabies information, and emergency protocols.

- DGHE Haryana Directive dated 25.11.2025


8. Mandatory Compliance:
